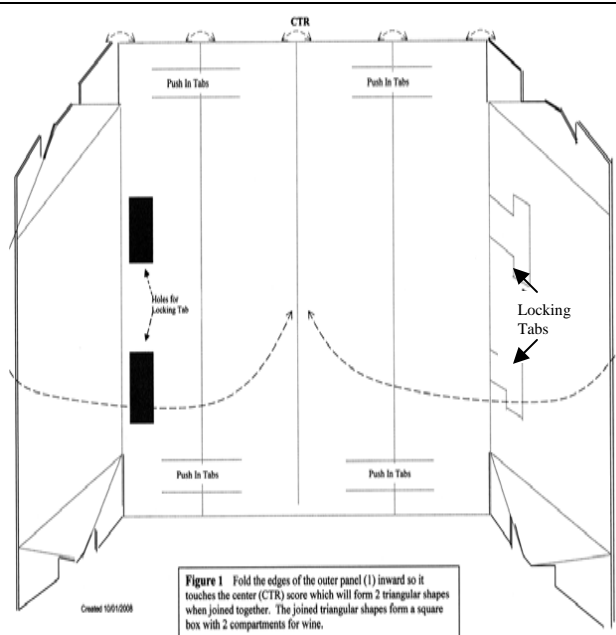


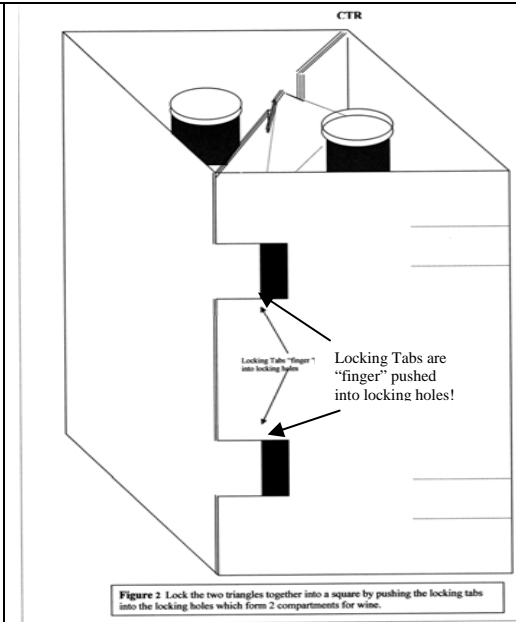
**STEP 1.** Begin by folding the outside panel (1) inward so that it touches the center (CTR) score as shown. Results in forming two (2) triangular shapes which when joined together created a “square” with two (2) symmetrical compartments which allow room for the insertion of 2 bottles of wine.



## HEXABOX FOLDING INSTRUCTIONS

### STEP 2.

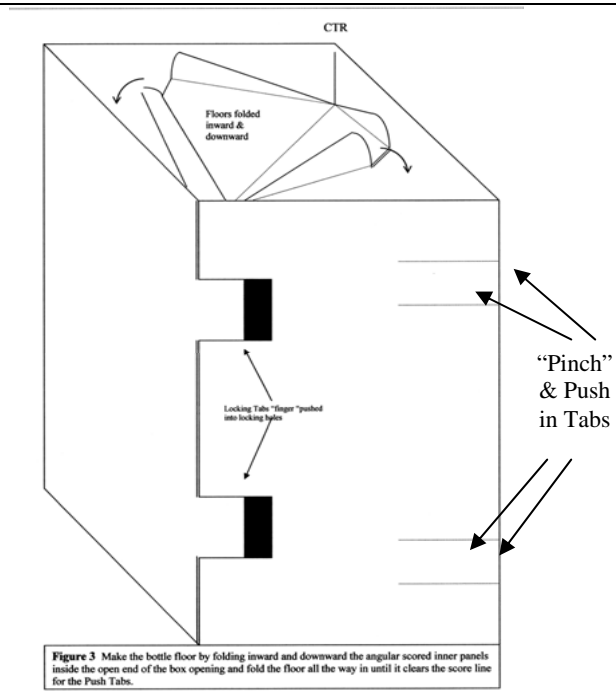
Once the two (2) triangular compartments are locked together by inserting (pushing) the two (2) LOCKING TABS into the locking tab cut outs on the opposite panel as illustrated. This will secure the two (2) half's together and keep them stabilized for the later insertion of the bottles.



### STEP 3.

Preparation for box for closure and bottle insertion.

At the open ends of each box you will find some “floor” closures which are have “angled” scores. Begin by folding the “floor with angled scores” inward and downward until the flat edge notch is level to a point where the outer push tabs will fold in under it. Once the floor has been folded properly it should be aligned evenly with the inside score of the Push Tabs. The push tabs are easily inserted by “Pinching and pushing” the outer corner at the same time. It will support the floor and keep it secure (Fig 4.) Fold the two (2) floors on one end of the bottle and set the box upright. It is now in a position (standing upright with open end at top) to receive the bottles for shipping.



### STEP 4.

The “floors” have been folded in so that the Push Tab is now placed directly below each “floor”. Once the bottles have been inserted into the container you can then repeat Fig 3. You may use the pushed in “Push Tabs” as a handle gripping it with your fingers to lift the wine and box up for inserting into the outer master carton for shipping.

**NOTE:** To remove stored bottles simply open one of the ends and slide bottle out of box! There is no need to dismantle the box.
